

New Book at the Nature Store

David Sarkozi, founding board member and current vice president, introduced his new book, *Birds of Texas*, at a presentation and book signing at the Texas Chenier Plain Refuges Visitor Center in July. The presentation included fascinating facts and stories that did not fit into the format of a field guide. For example, did you know black-bellied whistling ducks, one of the most common ducks in Texas, is mostly nocturnal?

The *Birds of Texas* is big, 614 pages, and includes 150 more species than other Texas Bird Guides. It includes local favorites



and rare curiosities that can be found in the Lonestar state. This full-color guide includes precise descriptions of voices, behaviors, habitats, and details of the top birding sites across the state. Signed copies are available for purchase in the FJNNWR <u>Nature Store</u>.

Planning for New Educational Trailer



With a \$50,000 donation from the estate of Lu Skillern and a \$30,545 grant, FJNNWR will fund an exciting new addition to our Education Program. It is a 14 ft customized enclosed trailer which will have educational displays and hands-on activities to expand our environmental education outreach into schools and

events within Chambers and surrounding counties. We expect to increase our education program to well beyond our current reach.

Each side of the trailer will have lift-up panels covering different aspects of the upper Texas coast. One side will teach about habitats, wildlife, plants, and more. The second side of the trailer will be a diorama illustrating the animals and plants that thrive in local wetlands emphasizing the importance of wetlands to our survival. A nocturnal display will be on the back of the trailer demonstrating the wildlife that thrives at night. There will be a wrap covering the outside of the trailer to draw attention to this treasure along the upper Texas coast that we call Jocelyn Nungaray NWR.

Jocelyn Nungaray NWR Audio Tour

This fall we anticipate completing a refuge Audio Tour funded by a \$5,000 grant from Texas Parks and Wildlife, Great Texas Birding Classic. The objective is to offer information on significant sites and activities on the Refuge as if the visitor had their own personal guide. Visitors may stop at designated places and listen to short audio clips describing various features of the landscape, wildlife, habitats, area history, and refuge operations and management.
